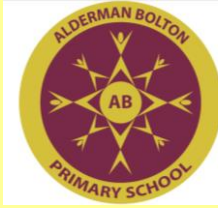
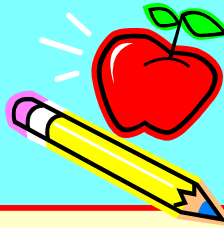

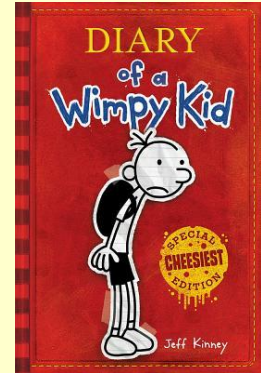
Title: Diary of a Wimpy Kid

Author: Jeff Kinney

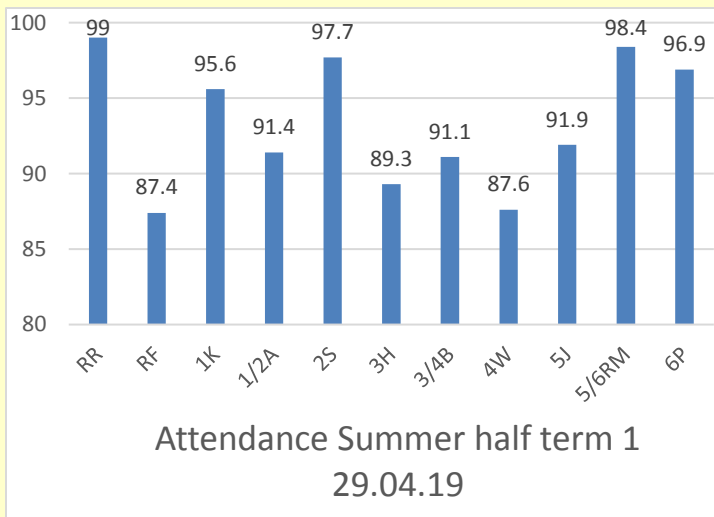
