<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Objective vs Non-objective collage <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Objective artwork refers to when the subject matter is easily recognisable b) Non-objective artwork is also known as abstract art, where the subject matter is not as recognisable.

Painting with paper technique to create an objective collage <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Called "painting with paper" because she makes her collages look like paintings by manipulating pieces of paper. b) Only uses a pair of scissors, acid-free glue sticks, and magazine strips to make each collage c) Usually seals it by painting on a layer of clear varnish
