This week in 5B...

This week class 5B have been writing a balanced argument about whether gorillas should or should not be kept in captivity. The children have worked hard to use formal language, present tense and lots of conjunctions.

In Maths we have been multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers by a single digit and showing our answers using a number of different methods including bar models, number lines, fact families and column method calculations. We have also been identifying squared numbers, prime numbers and composite numbers.

In science, we started the week by learning the different parts of a flowering plant. We then researched the life cycle of a plant. We illustrated this in our books and labelled the diagram with all of the correct vocabulary as well as written explanations of some of the new words we learned.

In History we learned about where and why the Anglo-Saxons settled in Britain. We identified these places on a map of the UK.

In computing we looked at a number of different scenarios regarding copywrite and plagiarism and discussed as a class what we should do in those situations.




Aldi Stickers
